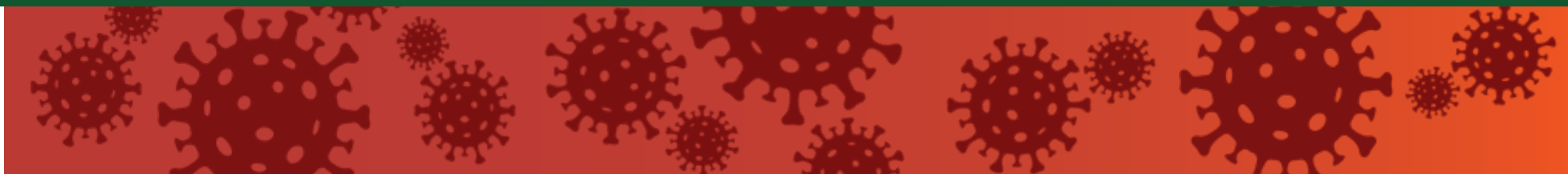

GMHA President's Letter

When I accepted the position of Board President last year, no one would have anticipated what a year it was going to be! GMHA had just finished a very successful 2019 season and was looking forward to a bright 2020. March brought stay-at-home orders and uncertainty as to what the future might bring. Travel restrictions and public gathering limits resulted in GMHA having to cancel all its events through June. All the outside organizations that hold competitions at GMHA canceled their seasons entirely. Finally in late June, some clarity came to the situation as the Vermont government issued travel guidance, eased gathering restrictions and opened hotels up to people from out of state. Through the hard work and adaptability of the GMHA staff, we were able to conduct events during the second half of the season. These were purposely smaller in nature as GMHA, competitors, officials and volunteers grappled with competing under these new circumstances.

Even with the successful events held during the second half of the season, GMHA was still left with a significant budget deficit. The GMHA Board was supportive of the efforts to run competitions, even at a loss, if they could be held safely. Fortunately, we were able to apply for and receive Federal and State grants that allowed GMHA to stay operational. However, going forward into 2021 and beyond is still a bit murky.

Some good news for our future is that in June GMHA was approached by a private foundation and was asked to submit a request for financial support to offset the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. We learned in August that we received a \$250,000 Challenge Grant from the Manton Foundation. This is an amazing opportunity for GMHA. Donations to GMHA will be matched 1:1 up to \$250,000, thereby doubling your gift. The grant will allow GMHA to rebuild its reserves as we head into uncertainty for the next couple of years.

On behalf of GMHA, I want to thank our members, business members, competitors, officials, donors, volunteers and everybody who makes GMHA so special in their support both this year and into the future. We hope that you all stay safe and that the success of vaccine distribution will begin to tame the pandemic. We are all looking forward to another successful year in 2021, however travel restrictions may still be in place for the first half of the year.

From the Executive Director

After starting as Executive Director on November 1, 2019, I was poised to continue the good work that all of us at GMHA had started under Tracy's leadership. A solid hard working staff was in place and was augmented in December by Wendy Allen starting as Office Manager and Trails Secretary. Our competitions were mostly at capacity and competitors were happy with their experience at GMHA. The outlook for the 2020 season was bright.

This all came to a halt for GMHA, New England and most of the Country in March. Community lockdowns, travel restrictions and uncertainty looking into the future put GMHA's 2020 season in doubt. GMHA quickly adapted by setting up the staff to work from home and worked on plans to move competition dates and as a last resort cancel them. We worked on management plans based on the current science that would allow competitors safely back onto the property to compete. The result was that all the events planned for May and June were cancelled or moved to later in the summer. Finally in the middle of June as Vermont eased restrictions, some clarity provided GMHA a way to start holding competitions. The event managers found officials, judges and volunteers willing to come to GMHA and met the continuing travel restrictions. These competitions were smaller, prohibited spectators and had social gathering restrictions but were able to happen. As happy as the competitors were about being able to compete, we at GMHA were happy to have them. The season ended with every discipline being able to have at least one competition.

Financially, cancelling half of the proposed competitions had a devastating impact on GMHA's revenues. Approximately 79% of GMHA's annual income is made up of entry fees. The Board was extremely supportive to the staff as we adapted with the changes and our efforts to hold competitions. At the end of the year, GMHA's financial situation was not as dire as had been forecasted to the Board in May. We are able to look forward to the 2021 season with the experience in how to put on competitions and with the optimism of that if we can handle 2020 then we can build on that for 2021. With the receipt of Federal and Vermont State grants, GMHA will be able to meet its obligations going into the 2021 season. Looking further into the future, GMHA's receipt of the Manton Foundation Challenge Grant in August will help solidify GMHA's financial position into the future. All donations to GMHA will be matched 1:1 up to \$250,000 through June 30, 2021.

These are exciting times and we hope to see you back at GMHA next year.

GMHA Recieves \$250,000 Challenge Grant from The Manton Foundation

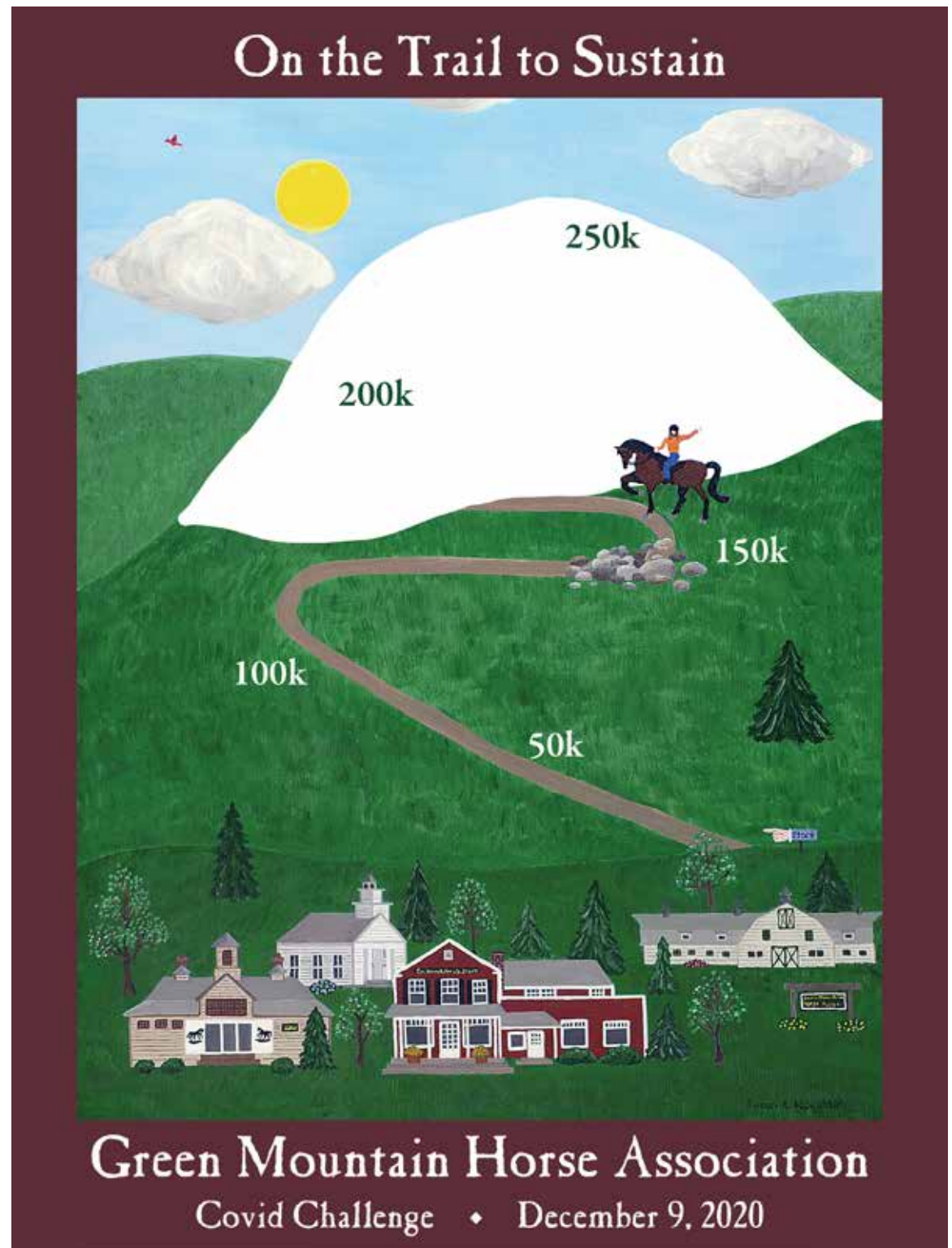
GMHA is pleased to announce the receipt of a Challenge Grant from The Manton Foundation. The goal is to expand the number of and deepen the engagement with GMHA's prospective and current donors during the COVID-19 period and beyond. GMHA is reaching out to the entire community to ask for support. All donations up to \$250,000 will be matched 1:1 through June 30, 2021.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic GMHA has had to cancel over half of its competitions and clinics during the 2020 season, thus creating a significant strain on the organization's finances. The Manton Challenge will substantially offset lost revenue and ensure that GMHA enters the 2021 season on sound footing.

GMHA thanks all of its members, competitors, business sponsors and donors for their continued support during this challenging time and invites them, and new members of the community, to help meet the Manton Challenge.

The Manton Foundation, established in 1991 by Jim and Gretchen Manton, has given out over \$300 million in grant funding to initiatives in the New England region of the country with an emphasis on relationship and community building. Jim Manton's success in the business world opened the door to start a charitable foundation to support the family's local and artistic interests. The Foundation is family-run and continues to engage with the equestrian community, including a \$250,000 matching grant for the USEA's frangible technology funding.

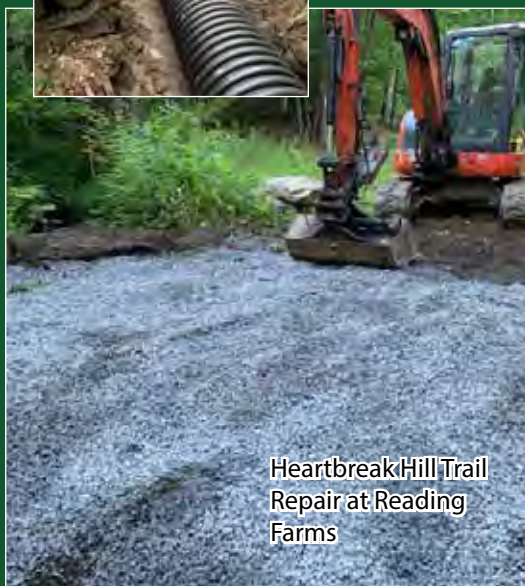

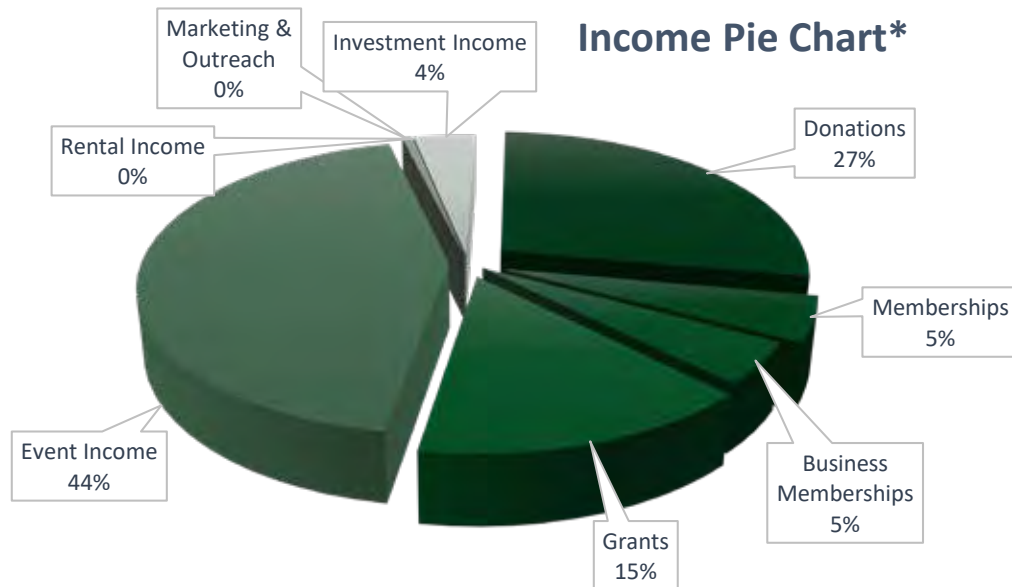

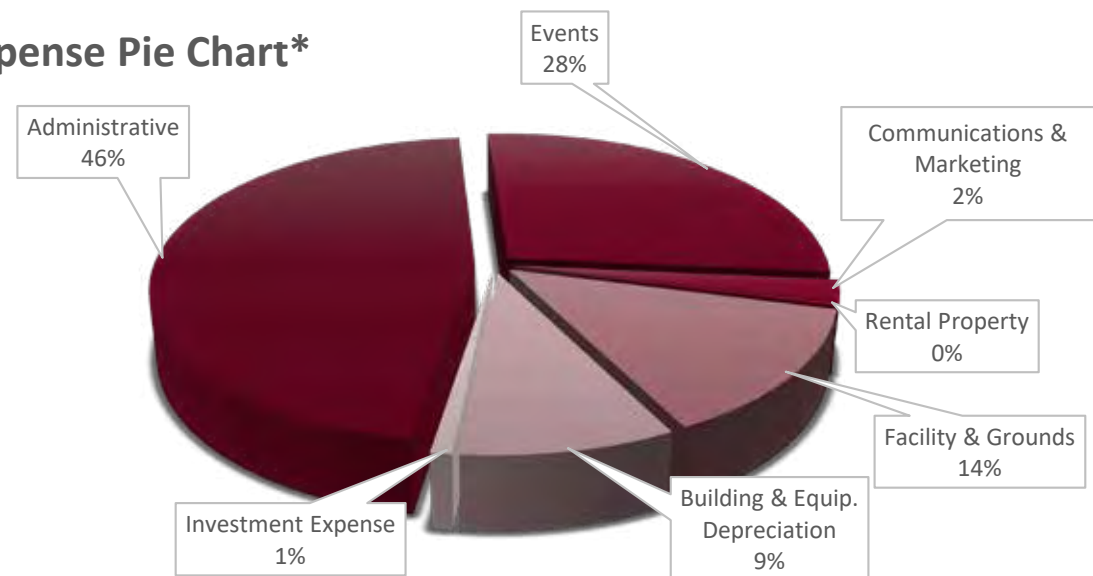
