GMHA's Bio-security regarding EHV 1/4

GMHA continues to monitor the recent outbreaks and concerns surrounding the highly contagious H1/H4 equine herpes virus. Out of respect for fellow participants and following recent updated protocol of GMHA's equine health policies, we ask that you take proactive precautions before traveling and while on grounds at GMHA.

- Please monitor your horse's temperature prior to departure.
- Avoid unnecessary horse to horse contact while on grounds and trails outside your stable group.
- Do not share water buckets/equipment or tack with others not in your stable group while at GMHA
- If your horse shows any signs of illness, fever, nasal discharge, lethargy or neurological symptoms, please remain home and consult your veterinarian immediately.

In addition, we ask that participants continue a daily temperature log of your horse, while on grounds and notify the office should there be any significant changes in their temperature (fever) so we may begin the necessary bio-security protocol for the safety of other participants and their horses. This includes notifying the on-call veterinarian and relocating the horse to isolation stabling, until an assessment by the vet may be made.

Thank you in advance for your compliance and cooperation, while enjoying your time at GMHA with your horse.
